BURR, JEHUE, England, 1600, had Jehue and John, born in England. Jehue had Daniel and Peter. Daniel had Rev. Aaron 1716, father of Aaron Burr. Peter, born 1667, had Thadeus, 1700; m., 1725, Abigail, d. of Jonathan Sturgis, and had Thadeus, of Fairfield, Conn., 1735, m. Eunice, d. of James Dennie, and Gershom 1744, m. Priscella, d. of Isaac Lothrop, of Plymouth. Gershom, Fairfield, had Gershom; Eunice, m. Barnabas Hedge, of Plymouth; Priscilla, m. a Buckley and Lewis Burr Sturgis; Abigail, m. a Capers.
